Effective **Monday, June 7, 2010**, we will no longer send you the producer's copy of Renewal Offers by mail. Instead, you will receive a list of your clients' residential property, commercial fire, and businessowners (BOP) renewal offers via e-mail on a weekly basis. We will continue to mail all renewal offers to policyholders via first class mail.

The producer's renewal list will include a summary of one week's renewals based on effective date. The list will be sent as a .pdf attachment one week after the actual renewal offer has been mailed to the insureds. Currently, renewal offers are sent to policyholders approximately 62 days before the existing policy term expires.

The list will include:

- The insured(s) name
- Policy number
- Renewal effective date
- Property address
- Total coverage amount (all applicable coverages combined)
- Total written premium
- The bill type, i.e. direct bill; mortgagee billed; or billed to others

The actual renewal offer can be accessed (and printed, if necessary) from our web-based online system.

This change is being made based on feedback from a number of producers. You will gain office efficiencies by no longer having to handle each individual piece of mail and the filing of paper. Future enhancements will include non-renewal and cancellation notices, and acknowledgement of payments received.
